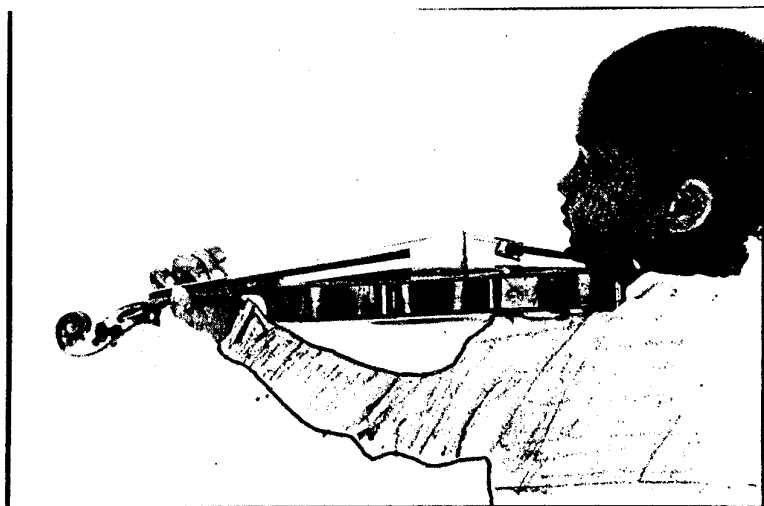


BEGIN WITH VIOLIN IN LEFT HAND IN RESTING POSITION

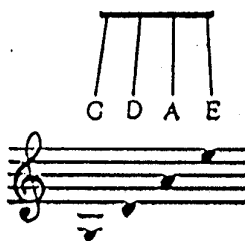
- 1 DUCK FEET
- 2 VIOLIN FOOT DUCK STEP
- 3 STATUE OF LIBERTY
- 4 TAP, TAP, TAP
- 5 VIOLIN RESTS ON TAP SPOT OVER VIOLIN FOOT
- 6 VIOLIN NECK RESTS ON 'TREE BRANCH'
- 7 RIGHT THUMB AGAINST 'THUMB SPOT'
- 8 INDEX FINGER SET, PULL, PLUCK
- 9 ANTS
- 10 RESTING POSITION

NOTE ON TUNING

The four strings of the violin are tuned, from left to right, G, D, A and E:



In the early stages tuning is mainly the responsibility of the teacher. Listen carefully as the teacher helps you tune your instrument and see if you can tell whether the note is "just right," or too low or too high.
